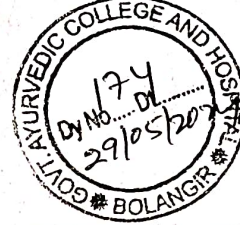

Subject:- Grant of conditional permission to Govt. Ayurved College, at Tulsi Nagar, Bolangir -767001, Odisha (AYU0210) with 57 seats (72 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course and 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Rog Nidan Avum Vikriti Vigyan- 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Govt. Ayurved College, at Tulsi Nagar, Bolangir -767001, Odisha (AYU0210) inspection of your College was conducted on 29.02.2024 & 01.03.2024 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Rog Nidan Avum Vikriti Vigyan- 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25 under Section 28 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2022", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

- Central Library:-**
 - There is short coming of 39 no. of books against the minimum requirement of 10000 total no. books as per MSR-2016.
- Teaching staffs:-**
 - Availability of total teaching staff for issuance of conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course after considering the teachers is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{27}{30} \times 100\% = 90\%$ (Excluding Excess and visitor observation report) which is not fulfilling the criteria as per Schedule-V of MSR 2016.

- 5) **Functionality of the hospital:-**

3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the 84th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 22.03.2024. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. dated 18.04.2024 to appear on 23.04.2024 before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to why not the conditional permission to your college with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 08 seats (10 seats including EWS) in 02 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Rog Nidan Avum Vikriti Vigyan- 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied.

4. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions vide ref. no. 853/GAC&H dated 19.04.2024 against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, Dr. Manoj Kumar Sahoo, Principal appeared before the Hearing Committee on 23.04.2024 and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Ayurveda college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

Post hearing submission - Documents verified and it is observed that Mr. Gadadhar Mahapatra shown and considered as Lab Technician in Hospital Staff hence he is not considered in Non teaching staff. Hence short coming of Lab Technician in Rog Nidan persists

b) Principal stated that Shalya Tantra OPD is functioning having special ano-rectal examination facilities. Hearing committee verified the documents and submission accepted.

c) Rachna deptt is not having cadaver and dissection room.

c) The dissection hall of this institution has been demolished due to dilapidated condition (vide Annex-O) of Executive Engineer(R&B), Bolangir. One cadaver had been preserved in the old dissection hall but it is not possible to preserve in other places so it was disposed. Further practical classes have been regularly taken in Virtual Anatomies Dissection table.

c) Principal The dissection hall of this institution has been demolished due to dilapidated condition and new dept of Rachna sharir is under construction. But No documents submitted hence Short coming persists.

d) Library has only 2 computers with no online subscription of journals.

d) After receiving of the funds for the Director, AYUSH, Odisha, the computer with all accessories to purchase and online subscription of journal will be procured for the year 2024-25 very shortly.

d) Principal stated that after receiving of the funds for the Director, AYUSH, Odisha, the computer with all accessories to purchase and online subscription of journal will be procured. But short coming persists.

5. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2022", "The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 87th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 25.04.2024.
6. Whereas, in view of the aforementioned shortcoming and deficiencies and as per the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and it is found that the college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 60 seats (75 Including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020. However, Board decided to issue conditional permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the academic session 2024-25.

As per the seat reduction policy:-

"For non availability of computerized Central Registration system seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by one seat."

Non Availability of Computerized central registration system - Principal stated that for OPD and IPD, proposal for procurement of 10 nos. of Computer system has already been submitted to the Director, AYUSH, Odisha. Documents were verified by the hearing committee members but Short coming still persists.

"For every 10% deficiency in Instruments, seat reduction in the Intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by one seat."

Availability of general and essential equipment's/Instruments - The Principal stated that the Director, AYUSH, Odisha has already started the process to procure the Instruments/Equipments very shortly through State Medical Corporation Ltd. Odisha. Documents were verified by the hearing committee members but till Date College did not procure the Instruments. Therefore, the Availability of Mean of general and essential equipment's/instruments is 57.55% which is not fulfilling the criteria as per the Regulation 11 of MSR 2016 and there is shortcoming of 17.5% in the Availability of Mean of general and essential equipment's/instruments.

Further, in accordance of Seat Reduction policy 2024-2025, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing three seats of the total Intake capacity.

Therefore, after applying the seat Reduction Policy, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for Issuance of conditional permission with 57 seats (72 seats including EWS) [Instead of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2024-25 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 57 seats (72 seats including EWS) [Instead of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats (19 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 07 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga- 02 seats (without EWS) (iii) Ras Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Prasuti & Stri Roga - 01 seat (02 seats including EWS) (v) Shalya Tantra-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

7. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above, conditional permission is granted to Govt. Ayurved College, at Tulsī Nagar, Bolangir -767001, Odisha (AYU0210) by reducing the intake capacity with 57 seats (72 seats including EWS) [Instead of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats (19 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-course and 07 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga- 02 seats (without EWS) (iii) Ras Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Prasuti & Stri Roga - 01 seat (02 seats including EWS) (v) Shalya Tantra-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under.
 - (i) It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 57 seats (72 seats including EWS) [Instead of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)] and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 15 seats (19 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota - the students admitted thereunder.
8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
9. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the Issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MABISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2025-26:
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.

- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - iv) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
 - v) The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 2 above, should be fulfilled.
12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
