Subject:- Matter related to grant of hearing in respect of conditional permission to Govt. Ayurved College Balangir, At TulasiNagar, Bolangir-767001 Orissa (Inst. ID- AYU0210) regarding permission for intake capacity in UG (BAMS) course with 60 seats (73 seats including EWS) and 08 seats in 02 PG courses (10 including EWS) in the subject namely (i) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan- 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24- regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

I am to here by state that, to verify the physical and other infrastructure facilities in respect of conditional permission to Govt. Ayurved College Balangir, At TulasiNagar, Bolangir-767001 Orissa (Inst. ID- AYU0210) for intake capacity in UG (BAMS) course with 60 seats (73 seats including EWS) and 08 seats in 02 PG courses (10 including EWS) in the subject namely (i) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan- 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Ayurved Samhita & Sidhant-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23, your College was visited on 11.05.2023 & 12.05.2023 on Hybrid mode by the visitation team of the Medical Assessment & Rating Board, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine.

Further, in view of above, the college has been assessed on the basis of concerned regulations and Relaxation policy Issued by the NCISM. On examining following condition were observed:-

1. **Teaching Pharmacy :-** No Quality Testing Laboratory Available.
2. **Animal House and Central Research Laboratory are not available.**
3. Mean of general and essential equipment's/instruments availability is 55.31%.
4. **Observation by the visitors: -**
 - a) Aatyayika (Emergency) OPD is not available.
 - b) Separate Shalakyia OT is not available.
 - c) Labour Room is not functional.
 - d) X-Ray machine in not in working condition. USG facility is not available. Records related to X-Ray and USG, ECG were not maintained properly.
 - e) No separate Minor and Major OT are available.
 - f) Cadavers in Rachana Sharir department was not found during visitation.

In view of above, assessment report was placed in the 41th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 29.05.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report, Board discussed the same and decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to your college.

Therefore, you are hereby given an opportunity of hearing on 01.06.2023 to appear before the designated Hearing Committee as appointed by President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM and present your case and clarify the above position and to show cause as to why not the conditional permission to your college for intake capacity in UG (BAMS) course with 60 seats (73 seats including EWS) and 08 seats in 02 PG courses (10 including EWS) in the subject namely (i) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan- 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Ayurved Samhita & Sidhant-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 as per section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.

Hearing, will be done virtually i.e., through video conferencing and the link, timing and other details of the same will be communicated separately.

It is further directed that you may make oral as well as written submissions before the designated hearing committee and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof in original (scanned format PDF) to substantiate your claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above and submit an authenticated copy for evidence/verifications to Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian system of Medicine on email i.e. president.marbism@ncismindia.org before 12:00 noon on 31.05.2023 as per necessity or in respect of shortcoming mentioned above only:-

- (i) The supporting documents may be the original/attested legible copies of the PG degree of the teachers/consented teachers, appointment order, joining letter, the attested copies of the experience certificates, the appropriate office order of the college for any reallocation, the attendance register up to the visitation day, Biometric attendance statement, the time table/duty roster indicating the engagement of the teachers, form 16/26AS, bank payment details for salary. PF /ESIC details, the details of the other duties as carried out by the teachers, leave record (if required) or any other documents related to availability of the teachers.
- (ii) The supporting documents may be in original/attested legible copies of the degree of the hospital staff, Part time teachers, non-teaching or other staff related to deficiencies mentioned above etc., appointment order, joining letter, the attested copies of the experience certificates, the appropriate office orders of the college for any reallocation, the attendance register up to visitation day. Biometric attendance statement, form 16/26AS, bank payment details for salary, PF/ESIC details. The time table/duty roster indicating the engagement of hospital staff, leave record (if required) or any other documents related to availability of the hospital staff/part time teachers/non-teaching staff, etc.
- (iii) The supporting documents may be with respect to the deficiency of OPD/IPD like web based computerized central registration system for maintaining the records of patients in OPD and IPD patients, laboratory and radiological investigation reports, IPD medicine dispensing registers, IPD diet register, duty rosters of hospital staff, birth and death certificates, etc. for the required period (01.01.2022 to 31.12.2022) to substantiate the claim of genuine functional hospital fulfilling the norms as specified in regulation (7) of notified RMS.
- (iv) The supporting/ relevant documents with respect to land, construction of college as well as hospital like architectural map/ proposed building Plan/ Zoning Plan/ Elevation Plan/ Department wise construction area as per RMS, 2016 and any other documents relevant to the deficiencies as indicated above.
- (v) Similarly, the supporting documents may be with respect to other deficiencies like Instruments/Equipment, Quality testing laboratory, Teaching pharmacy, functionality of College website, College Council, relevant undertaking, Central library, Herbal garden, Central Research Laboratory, Animal House, etc., (which ever applicable pertaining to the deficiencies).

It may also be noted that no further hearing opportunity will be given in case you do not attend the hearing at the stipulated time and date. Further, it will be presumed that you have nothing to say and required necessary action in terms of the NCISM Act and the relevant regulations thereunder will be taken based on available records.
